Regarding: Social Media Threat

Earlier today we were informed of a threat made on Social Media from a former student who did not name Dundee Community Schools but shared that he was wanting to harm students. Therefore, our district took this threat very seriously and enacted our school safety protocol where each of our academic buildings went on a "soft lockdown". We alerted local law enforcement to the situation who then placed officers at each of our buildings as additional measures of safety.

During the "soft lockdown" students were able to continue to move between classes, each lunch, and use the restroom. Our staff performed their duties in a professional, calm, and safe manner. We worked closely with local law enforcement agencies to communicate with them as to the status of their investigation as time progressed. Once we knew this former student was in police custody we then allowed our buildings to operate in a normal fashion. The safety of our students and staff are the highest priority of all administration of the school district.

I personally would like to thank all of the law enforcement officers and agencies who assisted us in this process as well as the students, staff, and families who worked closely to ensure the safety of everyone.
